Measures 1-3: Flute plays a melodic line starting with a quarter note G4, followed by a half note A4. Violin 1 and Harp are silent.

Measures 4-11: Violin 1 plays a melodic line with eighth and quarter notes.

Fl. Vln.1 Hp

Measures 20-27: Flute plays a melodic line with notes corresponding to the chords above. Harp plays a rhythmic accompaniment. *ad lib (play bass note)* is written below the Harp staff.

Measures 28-35: Flute plays a melodic line with notes corresponding to the chords above. Harp continues its rhythmic accompaniment.
