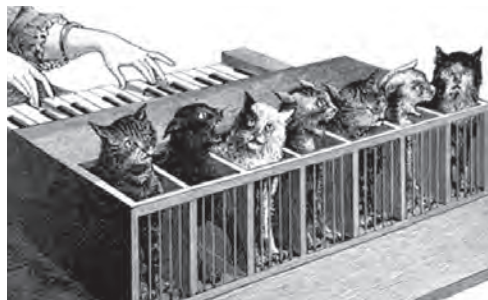
So mos el barco, so mos el mar

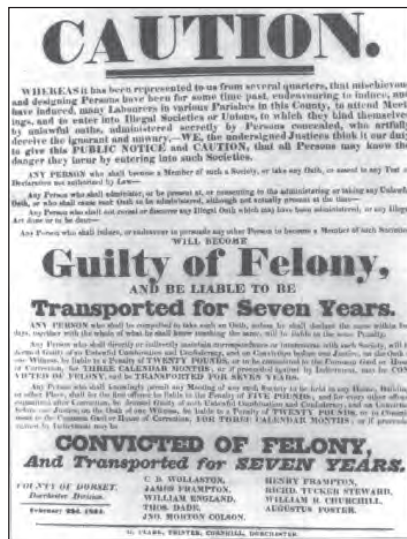

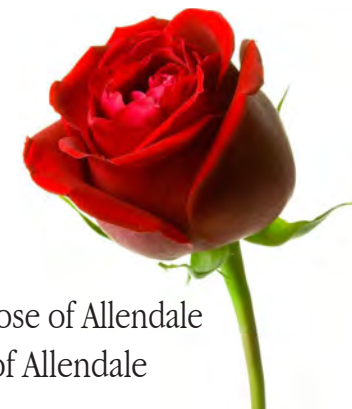
