So follow me down Cousin Jack.



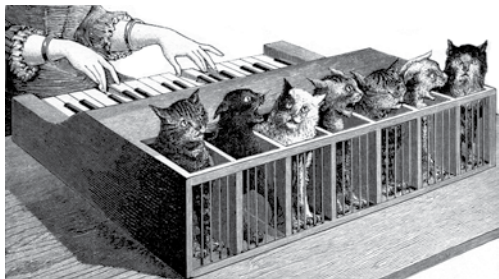
