Traditional Byzantine Art

The St Sava Serbian Orthodox Church is currently in the process of covering their entire walls and ceilings with Byzantine art. Drop in any Sunday from 11.45 - 12.30pm to have a look. Work on the cupola section (the dome) has been completed. Frescoes include the "Pantocrator" or "Christ the Almighty" which has been painted on the inside of the dome some 15 metres above ground level. At the base of the dome are the four Evangelists and extensive ornamental work.
