
Background Information

Shortly after midnight on October 7, 1998, 21 year old gay university student Matthew Shepard met two men at a hotel in Laramie, Wyoming who offered him a lift home.

After Shepard admitted that he was gay, the two men robbed him, pistol whipped and tortured him and then tied him to a fence in a remote, rural area where he was left to die.

Still tied to the fence, Shepard was discovered 18 hours later still alive but in a coma. He never regained consciousness and died the following Monday.

The anti-gay Westboro Baptist Church of Topeka, Kansas, picketed Shepard's funeral as well as the trial of his assailants, displaying signs with slogans such as "Matt Shepard rots in Hell", "AIDS Kills Fags Dead" and "God Hates Fags".
